<p>Saskatchewan Contact: Adrienne Hagen, Health Policy Analyst Saskatchewan Medical Association (306) 244-2196</p>	<p><b><i>Rural Relief Services and Locum Program</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Physicians are employed by the SMA to travel through Saskatchewan and replace local physicians who require short-term relief for 4-14 days in rural communities with three or fewer physicians</li> <li>▪ Reimbursement of costs of CMPA and CPS dues pro-rated for term of contract Mileage reimbursement or use of a leased vehicle</li> <li>▪ Accommodation and utilities</li> </ul> <p><b><i>Weekend On-Call Relief Program</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Travel expenses are reimbursed at current government rates</li> <li>▪ Locum receives \$1,175 in addition to FFS</li> </ul>
