

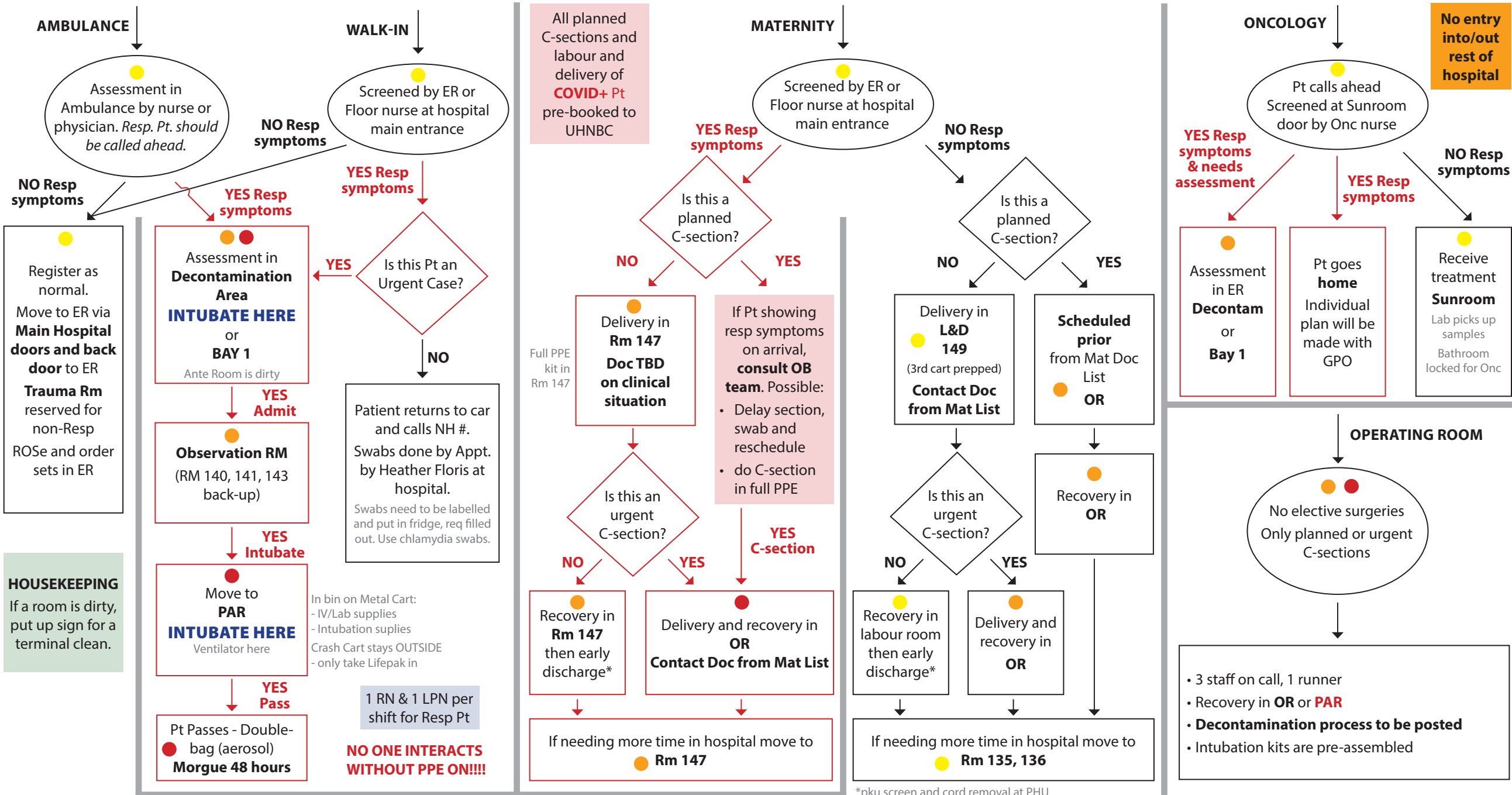
# Flow Chart for St. John Hospital : COVID-19 Response Plan

**Direct Patient Care:** surgical mask, gloves, goggles  
**COVID-19 Patient:** surgical mask, gown, gloves, goggles/face shield  
**Aerosol:** N95 mask, gown, gloves, goggles/face-shield, apron

**Patient arrives at SJH**  
 Doors open 8am-4pm

## Patient already at SJH

### INPATIENT

- Ward is cordoned off from Surgical Ward.
- IV blood draw kits available from lab. Nurses to draw blood when possible.
- Working on measure to decrease need to don/doff in patient rooms, such as baby monitors in patient rooms.

### LONG-TERM CARE

- Expected that all LTC Pts will be moved to SNM by April 11.
- If COVID-19+ on ward, is okay to still move LTC pt to SNM. Concern if outbreak on floor.
- Once transfer to SNM are made, Pts will NOT be transferred back to acute care, even if COVID-19+.

## PPE & Safety

### SUPPLIES

- Extra carts are available from the surgical side of the supply room.
- Carts are made up for COVID-only areas.
- Hard line cables ordered.

### PPE & SAFETY

- **NEW PPE guidelines (Mar 25)**  
**LINK to Guidelines**
- Mobile PPE Cart near Mat.
- Continuing SIMS and PPE donning/doffing training by staff. VIDEO LINK
- **Extra Training April 6-7**
- Physicians welcome to take PPE home to practice (investigating common location to store individual PPE kits)
- PPE kits are made and ready for use - in ER stores area and in PAR
- Recommendation that staff exposure to COVID-19 Pt does not exceed 4 hr.

## Service Areas at SJH

### LAB

- PHASE 2 response - only essential testing, no FIT tests, appointment only, shorter hours.
- Picking up from Onc.
- Kits are available:
  - ER blood draw kits
  - Pre-blood collection kits
  - IV blood draw kits

### X-RAY

- No X-rays in decontamination room.
- X-ray post intubation not recommended.

### PHARMACY

- No specific instructions here yet.

### LAUNDRY

- Uniform protocol for staff:
  - bring work clothes from home, change at hospital out of street clothes
  - bag up work clothes after shift to take home to launder (no special needs)
  - wear street clothes out of hospital
  - all this with proper hand washing
- Contaminated laundry goes into plastic bag then into laundry bin.
- Shower bags hanging in each shower.
- Look for protocols near shower - coming soon.

### CLEANING

- Cleaning regular Pt rooms
- Cleaning COVID-19+ Pt room
- Hang sign on door of rooms that need terminal cleaning.
- Limited staff, will call support service supervisor when need to add staff.

### ADMINISTRATION

- **Social Distancing**, as long as no patient or public contact.

### MAINTENANCE

- Work in regular Pt rooms or general hospital
- Work in COVID-19+ Pt room
- No specific instructions here yet.

### FOOD SERVICES

- Serving food to regular rooms
- If serving food to COVID-19+ Pt room

## Community Working Group

### MEETINGS WITH COMMUNITY COVID-RESPONSE GROUP

#### UPDATE

CWG looking to support these areas:

- Housing/accommodations for staff/physicians that are unable to return to their homes due to high-risk family members.
  - ATCO trailers from Pipeline camp may be available for isolation housing.
- Will share cleaning/laundry NH recommendations to group.
- Hospital staff may be able to provide cleaning protocols to hotel cleaning staff.
- Ambulance will share cleaning/laundry recommendation on their website.
- Inquiries will be made to local businesses and larger industry in both Vhf and FL to source appropriate protective eyewear. Look for source of funding to cover costs.
- Will provide current stats to community group.
- DoV wondering if SJH will serve other communities and planning around that.
- NeighbourLink providing food to people in need in Vhf and Saik'uz.
- Group planning on creating a website to communicate to community - 1-2 weeks.
- Mayor Thiessen will confirm availability of daycare from the YMCA. Ken Young to get daycare information from SD91 too.
