Full-time positions: 12 hour shifts = 10 to 12 per month OR 24 hour shifts = 6 to 8 per month

Part-time positions: 12 hour shifts = 6 shifts per month OR 24 hour shifts = 4 per month

Options for enhanced corporate contracts including rural family medicine (+/- anesthesia), inpatient care, surgical assisting and/or Rapid Access Addiction Medicine clinic work are also available. Call us to create a practice mix that best supports your interests!

Note: Hospital privileges are granted across all six GBHS sites, therefore extra ED shifts at other GBHS hospitals may also be available.
