We offer assessment, evidence-based treatment and recovery-oriented rehabilitation across a broad range of needs including acute care, psychosocial rehabilitation and outreach, geriatric mental health, youth mental health, concurrent disorders, and care for adults with dual diagnosis.

We offer physicians career development opportunities in teaching and research, quality improvement and leadership/administration. Waypoint has academic affiliations with five Ontario medical institutions and candidates will be encouraged to apply for a university appointment if they do not already have one. Preference will be given to a candidate who is interested in teaching, quality improvement and/or research, and who thrives as part of a collaborative team.

We are accepting expressions of interest by candidates who hold an MD or equivalent and certification in Psychiatry from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and who are eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario. Current priority areas include general adult inpatient psychiatry and regional geriatric mental health services.
