The Northeastern Manitoulin Family Health Team and the Manitoulin Health Centre are seeking a family physician to join our experienced health care team in January 2022. With a progressive practice and generous incentives, you and your family can enjoy all that Manitoulin has to offer.

Practice Requirements:

- Low Risk Obstetrics to ensure the continuity of obstetrics within our group
- Part of the Northeastern Manitoulin Family Health Team
- ER preferred

Practice Includes:

- 37 days of locum funding through Health Force Ontario (HFO)
- Teaching and Research opportunities with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine
- Equitably divided on-call schedule at the Manitoulin Health Centre
- Visiting specialists, Telederm, and e-consults

Compensation and Incentives Include:

- Rural and Northern Physician Group Agreement (RNPGA)
- ER payment supplemented through the Scott Sessional Program plus HOCC, LTC on-call funding, shadow billing, fee-for-service procedures
- Community eligibility of \$109,920 grant (Northern and Rural Recruitment and Retention Initiative), paid over four years by the MOHLTC
- Relocation assistance

The Northeastern Manitoulin Family Health Team (NEMFHT) is a multidisciplinary team located in Little Current, Manitoulin Island. The team is comprised of six Physicians, two Nurse Practitioners, two Registered Nurses, 2 Registered Practical Nurses, a Pharmacist, a Social Worker, a Dietitian and two physician assistants.

Together, the NEMFHT provides primary healthcare services to the catchment area, including Little Current, 3 first Nations communities and 2 nursing homes.

The physicians at the NEMFHT also provide on-call coverage at the Manitoulin Health Centre; a Health Centre equipped with a 24-Hour Emergency Department, 16 medical/surgical /peds beds, 2 combined care (OBS) and day surgery.

Little Current is a scenic town with a population of 1,500 serving 6,000. Its natural beauty and variety makes the Manitoulin area a sought-after recreational destination. Popular pastimes are kayaking, fishing, hiking, sailing, cross-country skiing and snowmobiling. Cultural events include theatre productions, musical evenings, arts and crafts events.
